Dear parents and carers

Before the Easter holidays we wrote to all parents and carers about the changes to the skirts and trousers which come into effect in September. All skirts and trousers are £15. Photographs are overleaf to help you.

### Girls

The new skirt is Taylor Tartan and is available in one length only with waist sizes up to 40" and with an internal waist adjuster. The new trouser will have a King's identification tab on the waistband and it is available in three different leg lengths.

### Boys

The new King's trouser will have a King's identification tab on the waistband and it is available in three different leg lengths.

### School uniform requirements – a reminder

To remind all of the requirements for uniform. The compulsory uniform comprises a blazer displaying the school logo, a white shirt, a school tie and either the school skirt or trousers. If wearing a skirt, students must wear black tights; if wearing trousers, black socks must be worn. School shoes are to be leather or leatherette and not in a trainer style – there must be no canvas on the shoe and they must be entirely black.

For Physical Education, students must wear school kit – there are multiple options available including a t-shirt, an outdoor jumper, tracksuit bottoms, shorts or skort – students are **not** expected to own all items of the kit. Students must wear blue football socks and proper sport trainers for all physical activity.

### Our supplier

We continue to use the **National Schoolwear Centre, Hanley** as our supplier; we have worked hard to ensure the very best price for all of our school uniform and we are proud that it continues to be cheaper than most secondary school uniforms. All new compulsory will be available to pre-order from 2 May 2016 from the store. Uniform events are being held in school on 7 July 2016 from 6pm until 7:30pm and two late evenings in the store on 21 July and 28 July until 7pm – they expect these dates to be extremely busy.

There is a pre-order facility, whereby the store will hold all items until collected for a £10 deposit. There is also the opportunity to use the savings club facility where payments can be made against the order in person or over the phone (01782 272991).

All uniform **must** be purchased before 15 August 2016 – the store and the school are unable to guarantee supply of compulsory school uniform items before the start of the new term unless ordered before this date.

Please be reminded that students are required to wear full school uniform every day and that non-compliance may result in fixed term exclusion and or internal exclusion.
