Re: The King's School uniform and PE kit with effect from September 2015

School uniform is an important aspect of our school and it is important that all students and families support the uniform code. As we approach the summer holidays, please take the time to take note of the information below.

<p>Compulsory:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Blazer • School badge • School tie • Tailored trousers or smart school skirt* • Socks or tights • White school shirt • Plain black school shoes (NOT trainers) <p>*Skirts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee, and must be tailored; leggings are <u>not</u> part of our school uniform.</p> <p>Optional:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grey v-necked jumper (NOT sweatshirt) 	<p>Compulsory:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • T-shirt • Shorts or skort • Trainers • Socks <p>Optional:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tracksuit bottoms • Outdoor top <p>Please note <u>all PE Kit</u> must be sourced from the National Schoolwear Centre, Hanley, except socks and trainers.</p>

As we are changing the PE Kit, students in new years 8-10 are eligible for a funded t-shirt and pair of shorts/a skort. This may be collected from school on the evening of Thursday 9th July between 7:15pm and 8:30pm, or throughout the summer holidays from the shop in Hanley (National Schoolwear Centre). The Schoolwear Centre staff will be able to accept payment by either card or cash (no cheques are acceptable) and the full range of uniform and PE kit will be available both in school on 9th July and from their shop in Hanley. Students in Y11 are not required to wear the new PE kit.

Please accept this letter as a reminder that students are expected to wear their blazer around school every day and that this is a compulsory (not optional) part of the school uniform.
