

Accelerated Reader – Sept 16 – July 17

- The proportion of disadvantaged pupils requiring intervention or urgent intervention has fallen over the period Sept 2016 to Sept 2017.

	Sept 2016	Sept 2017
Intervention	12%	8%
Urgent Intervention	11%	9%

- Disadvantaged boys across the school requiring intervention has fallen from 18% to 11% in this time period. More disadvantaged boys are now reading in line with national expectations relative to their ages.
- The proportions of disadvantaged pupils in year 8 and 9 at or above national age related expectations has risen significantly

Disadvantaged boys in year 8 have seen a threefold increase in the proportion at or above national age related expectations (from 11% to 33%). No disadvantaged girls in year 9 require urgent intervention (an 11% decrease)

Disadvantaged boys in year 9 have increased the proportion at or above national age related expectations to 46%, from 27% in Sept 2016. Similarly disadvantaged girls have improved to 64%, from 58% in Sept 2016.

- The age standardised scores (which compares pupil performance to a national average of 100, taking age into account) for disadvantaged pupils show increases across all participating year groups:

- The AR mentoring group has 6 disadvantaged pupils all of whom improved their age standardised scores closer to the national average of 100. In most cases these pupils saw very positive gains in their reading ages:

- The Year 7 literacy Catchup mentoring group has 4 disadvantaged pupils, the majority of whom improved their age standardised scores closer to the national average of 100. In most cases these pupils saw very positive gains in their reading ages:
