



Annual reward trip – September 2019 onwards

For a pupil to be eligible for the annual school reward trip, held in July, they must meet or exceed explicit criteria from internal data accumulated over the first two terms (Autumn and Spring). **These criteria are a minimum expectation.**

To be successful a pupil must:

1. Have an average progress score of zero or better (i.e. on average they are making at least expected progress in all of their subjects)
2. Have an average ATL score of 2 or better (i.e. on average they are demonstrating at least a good attitude to learning)
3. Have an average commitment to homework of 2 or better (i.e. on average they are demonstrating at least a good commitment to homework)
4. Show that in all of their subjects they are equipped to learn
5. Have an average attendance level of 96% or better
6. Not have exceeded 20 behaviour points over the course of the school year
7. Not have been on a senior leader report card at any point during the school year
8. Not have accrued more than 30 minutes of 'lates' to school or lessons over the course of the school year
9. Not have been internally excluded or incurred a fixed term exclusion

Pupils who fully meet these criteria will be **notified first** and given a letter confirming their selection

Pupils may be selected for the annual reward trip who do not meet all of the above criteria at the head teacher's discretion. These pupils will be **notified second** and also given a letter confirming their selection.
